Since 1992, the Perrenoud Foundation organizes the International Music Competition (IMC). The IMC is opened to musicians of any nationality, without age limit. The IMC gives the possibility for the prizewinners to perform in prestigious locations, to record a music video, to publish a CD and DVD and to be promoted internationally.

■ APPLICATION

The applicants have to apply for the IMC on our website:

and have to pay the Application Fee.

■ AUDITION

The participants will be invited to perform a music program of their own choice, solo or with piano accompaniment, for a approximately duration of 40 minutes. The performance will be recorded on audio and video.

■ COMPETITION

The participants will be promoted to music managers, orchestras, radio - TV broadcasting and influent personalities of the music world. The international jury will judge the participants and choose the prizewinners. For the public vote, the selected participants will be presented on the internet.

■ PRIZES

DIPLOMAS

Will be awarded in each category and instrument.

CONCERT

The prizewinners will be invited for a concert in PARIS.

CD & DVD PUBLISHING

The recording of the prizewinners will be published on CD and DVD.

The prizewinners will benefit of a large marketing promotion.
